LADWP had planned to install a 230KV electrical transmission line underneath Inglewood Blvd. But due to protests from concerned residents and property owners, in January 2010, LADWP agreed that they had to do an environmental review of the proposed Scattergood-Olympic Transmission Line Project.

As part of the environmental review, LADWP is now seeking public comment. There will be two meetings.

It is important that the Inglewood Blvd. residents attend one of these two meetings to let LADWP know that you are opposed to having the transmission line run down our narrow residential street. Since we also have natural gas & oil pipelines underneath Inglewood Blvd., installing an electrical transmission line on our street could possibly have terrible consequences like the San Bruno gas line explosion resulting in loss of life and homes lost.
